As you go about your normal daily routine and have conversations with your child, the following are ideas that may help further your child's progress in science.

Ask students to study the planets and order - iPads can be used to research the planets.

- Students can record the phases of the moon each night using diagrams, pictures, and captions.
- Use different constellation apps to observe stars throughout the solar system.
- Trace shadows of themselves during morning, noon, and evening.
- Discuss how seasons are affected by the Earth's tilt and revolution.
