

Sample Incentives

For individuals:

- Make one of your bulletin boards a Twitter board. When students do something positive they get to write a tweet to be posted.
- Keep a special rolling chair, like the teacher's chair, that students get to sit in for the day, as a reward.
- Purchase a few leis from the Dollar Tree. When a student's average improves by a set amount of points they are awarded by being able to wear a lei for a day.
- Students receive a sticker on their notebook.
- Students receive tickets to redeem for something they desire.
- Discourage bathroom visits during class, with a system in which students receive a pass at the start of the nine weeks, redeemable for 3 visits to the restroom. If at the end of the nine weeks they have not been to the restroom during class, their pass is redeemable for a prize, points, etc. The more passes they still have left the larger the redemption. If students go more than 3 times, each time they must stay after to pick up papers and things from the classroom floor.

For the whole class:

- On a separate board, or in a designated are of the board, keep track of things such as:
 - class average
 - class behavior rating
 - number of days all students have been present
 - class average on the last benchmark test

*Be inclusive. Think about students who may never earn an A, but can contribute to the class incentive by being present, earning the highest grade they can, etc.

- Rewards may include:
 - Class is held outside.
 - Students may have music while they work.
 - Students each may bring a soda to class.
