<p>Mini-Lesson</p> <p>10-15min</p>	<p>Teacher introduces the day's topic with a question. The question should be relevant, thought-provoking, and open-ended. *Students may be required to write the question and some of the responses</p> <p>Question for the day:</p>		
<p>Independent Work</p> <p>10-20min</p> <p>Which will occur first?</p>	<p>Students are assigned a task to work on alone. During this time the teacher moves about the room to assist students, as needed.</p> <p>Describe the task.</p>

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<p>Sharing</p> <p>5-10min</p>	<p>Teacher guides whole class to share what they learned based on mini-lesson discussion, independent work, and small group work.
